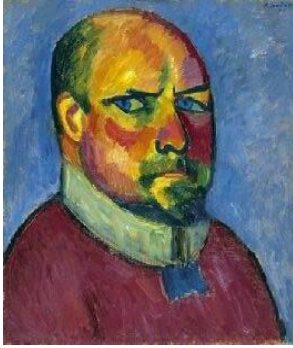

Portrait Painting Workshop with Ron Reynolds

Saturday 13th November 10.00am -4.00pm

Producing a portrait painting is one of the more challenging subject matters for artists. Not only is a physical likeness expected but some sort of psychological insight is also anticipated! It can be an intimidating procedure. Ron Reynold's approach to teaching portraiture breaks down this barrier and encourages the student to go beyond 'getting a good likeness' by exploring the methods employed by artists like Modigliani, Matisse, Dix, Jawlensky, Picasso, Roualt, Vuillard, Dubuffet and Soutine. In this workshop, Ron will analyse the methods these artists used as a way of liberating your own unique expression. This is not a traditional approach to portraiture and it is for painters with some experience and a sense of adventure.

Requirements:

Your painting equipment (any medium) or collage materials.

Four 12" X 16" canvas/boards/suitable painting paper.
